

Toronto-based Punk-Rockstar Feura makes music for the bold and rebellious. Selected as Canadian Musicians Cooperative Emerging Artist from 2021-2024 and a 2022 Honey Jam Artist, Feura uses her artistry to create space for BIPOC and LGBTQ2+ representation within Gen-Z rock communities, while challenging mainstream stereotypes of the ideal rockstar. With a growing following of over 170K+ people online, they continue to empower fans to be unapologetically themselves.

Touring and creating high-quality live entertainment is the epicenter of their artistic practice. Feura is regularly booked throughout Ontario and Quebec at various venues and festivals, playing 30+ shows this year. Notable performances include Pride Toronto's 2024 Youth Stage, Side by Side weekend in Ottawa, as well as the Emerging Artist Showcase Tour and ONXS music festival with the Canadian Musicians Co-operative.

Apart from directing their own band, Feura also worked as the Artistic/Music Director for The Canadian Musicians Co-operative's 2024 Emerging Artist Showcase, crafting a three-hour-long show and directing a cast and crew of 45+. This has been the biggest production they have worked on to date with a budget of 200K. Feura continues to help to mentor other emerging artists with their live performances skills, and live show production.

Feura is currently working toward the release of their debut album and is continuing to invite diversity and inclusion in the music scene through representation, education, and unabashed self-expression!
